Additional Information / Reasons for Decision

Contact was reported at the Hairpin (Turn 18) on the last lap of the race during Heat 1, between Car 29, Car 34 and Car 122. On board footage was viewed from all cars involved and all drivers were also interviewed. It appeared that due to an overtake happening at the front of this particular group of cars on track, it caused a concertina effect which led to Car 122 (the last car in the train of cars making front to rear contact with the car in front, which in turn caused the same between the next two cars.
