### Additional Information / Reasons for Decision

Multiple cars were involved in an incident that occurred on the start line at the start of the Heat 4. Car 79 made contact with Car 33 who subsequently made contact with Car 3, with Car 33 and car 3 both making contact with the pit wall, unable to continue.

After reviewing ITV recorded footage from various camera angles and interviewing Car 3, Car 33 and Car 79 it become clear that the incident was caused by the start lights being left on for longer than usual, leading to the cars getting too close to the gantry, leaving them unable to see the start lights. This caused the drivers at the front to react slower to the lights being extinguished, than the cars behind and due to the unique nature of the championship's race starts which sees the cars very close together, led to a concertina effect of cars hitting one another. Car 3 and Car 33 were also very close side by side which exacerbated the problem.
