Judicial hearing carried out at Donington Park 29/08/2025 due to time constraints at Croft.					
Cars 96 and 171 made contact into the Hairpin causing car 171 to spin. It was noted in the judicial hearing that car 96 did have a sufficent overlap and the point of turn in.
