Cars 96 and 171 made contact into the Hairpin causing car 171 to spin. It was noted in the judicial hearing that car 96 did have a sufficient overlap and the point of turn in.

Both drivers and team managers interviewed and on board footage from cars 96, 171 & 40 (evidence car).
