## **24 HEURES CAMIONS LE MANS 2025**

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

#### **1. PADDOCK FACILITIES**

##### **1..1. Paddock arrival**

- The paddock will be accessible from **Thursday, September 18th, at 9:00 a.m. until 9:00 p.m. at the latest (for truck arrivals in the paddock), and then again on Friday morning from 8:00 a.m.**
- Before arriving at the circuit, you must go to the Accreditation Center, located at Stade Marie Marvingt (same as in 2024) → see attached map with opening hours.
- Please note: if you arrive in several groups, you will need to prepare additional envelopes directly at the Accreditation Center, using their labeled envelopes.
- You must have your accreditation passes to enter the circuit.
- The South Gate will remain open non-stop until Sunday evening, but from Thursday morning onwards, you will need your accreditation passes to enter.
- **IMPORTANT: no cars will be allowed in the paddock. They must be parked in the P2B parking lot or in the free outside parking area (if not respected, cars may be towed).**
- **IMPORTANT: as last year, no more than 200 liters of fuel may remain in the tanks of your trucks.**

##### **1..2. Teams motorhomes**

- If the driver has a motorhome, it must be parked strictly at the rear of your structure.
- No motorhomes should be visible at the front of your structures.

##### **1..3. Paddock departure**

- Teams may vacate the paddock from the end of the last race on Sunday until Monday at 12:00 p.m.

##### **1..4. WIFI**

- Individual Wi-Fi codes will be provided to you.

##### **1..5. Movement within the paddock**

- The maximum speed for electric scooters and mopeds is limited to 30 km/h. Wearing a helmet is **MANDATORY**.

##### **1..6. Animals**

- For your information, animals are not allowed inside the circuit grounds.

We kindly remind you to review the internal regulations of the Le Mans Circuit.

## 2. ACCREDITATIONS

**2..1.** Contents of the envelope (to be collected at the Accreditation Center; the envelope will be in the driver's name by default—please inform us if he is not the first driver) :

- 8 x track accreditations with photos
- 8 x general paddock accreditations (also to be processed in the accreditation software)
- 2 x P2B parking passes
- 1 x P4A parking pass per team trailer (which will be scanned at the entrance)
- 1 x P4A parking pass for the driver's motorhome
- Each parking sticker must be affixed to the vehicle's windshield. Please note that each sticker, once affixed, cannot be removed or replaced

**2..2.** Additional tickets

- If you wish to purchase additional access beyond your allocation, please return the ticket order form to us.

**2..3.** Media accreditation

- To obtain media accreditation, you must submit a request by email to [l.olivier@lemans.org](mailto:l.olivier@lemans.org) before September 10<sup>th</sup>.

## 3. ADMINISTRATIVE AND TECHNICAL CHECKS

**3..1.** Administrative checks

- Administrative checks will take place on Friday, September 19th, from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. at the Sports Module reception office.
- Please, present the driver's license and any other required documents.

**3..2.** Technical checks

- Technical checks will take place on Friday, September 19th, from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and from 2:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m., at the Technical Box located under the Welcome Center.

## 4. OFFICIAL PHOTO - DRIVERS (in racing suits + helmet)

- Friday, September 19, from 11:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. on the track,
- This photo is mandatory for all French, European, and British drivers.

## 5. OFFICIAL PHOTO – TRUCKS

- Friday, September 19, from 4:15 p.m. to 5:05 p.m. on the fast line,
- This photo is mandatory for all French, European, and British race trucks,
- The marshals will be present on the track to guide you.

## 6. DRIVERS' BRIEFINGS

Drivers' briefing:

- Friday, September 19, at 5:15 p.m., in briefing room No. 305 (3<sup>rd</sup> floor of the Paddock Building),
- Attended by the drivers as well as the team manager.

## 7. PILOTS TRACK WALK

- Friday, September 19, from 7:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m., on foot or by bicycle.

## 8. OFFICIAL OPENING CEREMONY – 24 HEURES CAMIONS


An official opening ceremony with all the race trucks (CDF, ETRC, and BTRC) will be organized on track during the 24 Heures Camions. All trucks will take part in the event, along with your teams.

**Schedule : Saturday / 1:35 p.m. – 2:25 p.m.**

5 wristbands per entered race truck will be distributed : 1 driver + 4 mechanics in Team uniform. Only accredited media photographers wearing an ACO bib will be allowed on track.

Protocol to be followed by each Team :

- Positioning of the trucks on the track, 2 by 2, following the instructions of the marshals on track,
- Grid walk with speakers including driver interviews,
- Then, line-up of each Team next to their truck on the inside of the track (see photo below, driver standing by the truck, facing the direction of the track),
- → **respect this line-up !**
- No photographers allowed on track during the line-up,
- French national anthem: *La Marseillaise*.
- Formation lap for BTRC trucks for grid formation (same as 2024).



## 9. MOBILE APP – FRENCH TRUCK CHAMPIONSHIP

To follow all the news of the Championship across our Truck Grand Prix events, WHEELS RACING has developed a mobile app called “**CHAMPIONNAT DE FRANCE CAMIONS**”, available now on Google Play and the Apple Store.
