Following investigations, I find that:

Under parc ferme conditions the championship technical director collected data logger information as per standard procedure in line with championship regulations.

It was reported that car 21 did not have any available data from laps 1-9 of the session. There is data available from laps 10 & 11. After reviewing the on board evidence it is clear the car made a pitstop on the completion on lap 9 and that team personnel plugged into the dash before releasing the car.

Additional Information / Reasons for Decision / Evidence:

After speaking with the technical director (Andy Menzies) in the presence of the eligibility scrutineer (Steve Fitzgerald) it was confirmed that during the pitstop the cosworth dash was 'flashed', i now understand this is a data reset.

As a result i believe this is a breach of: CR5.20 d).

However there is mitigating circumstances which include; there was no significant changes made during the pitstop (front left wheel change) and the fact there are 2 laps of data available after the pitstop.

As a result it is clear there is a breach of regulation however due to mitigation i believe the below penalty is appropriate.

Accordingly under Motorsport UK NCR **Ch.5, Pt.A, App. 5, Art. 2.3 (c)** I order

Drivers fastest lap in the Qualifying session is deleted.

Penalty points will be recorded on your licence as a result of the above

You are advised of your right of appeal under **NCR Ch.2, App.4**
