Following a hearing and reviewing video evidence, I find that you are guilty of contravening,


NCR 12.7.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car

In that an apparent lack of control of the car resulted in contact being made with car 27 on the approach to turn 2, which was then forced onto the grass and as a result car 27 spun and stopped with damage to the car

Therefore, under NCR 2.2.2 and CR 4.2, I order that you should:
