Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s):

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car concerned

Brief Details:

Contact occurred between Cars 12 and 14 on the entry to Turn 1 (Redgate). Car 12 braked and changed down well before the corner but the car failed to slow sufficiently making slight contact with Car 14 near the apex of the corner. Car 14 spun resulting in contact with another vehicle. It is considered that the incident was probably caused by slick tyres not being up to appropriate temperature on Car 12.

Evidence Relied Upon:

In car video evidence from both vehicles and interview of both drivers.

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK NCR Ch.5A App.5 Art.2.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:
