Lap 5 disallowed due to track limits

The Clerk of the Course, having examined Photographic evidence [Evidence], summoned and heard from The driver of car 23 (and their signed on PG) / judge of fact for track limits [the Entrant(s) name(s)], determines the following:

**Decision:**

There is a significant and relevant new element which was unavailable to the parties seeking the review at the time of the decision concerned

**Reason:**

The imagery from the Judge of Fact does not show that the driver of car 23 had breached the limits of the track on lap 5. The sensor had triggered however this was not supported by the photographic evidence provided. The Judge of Fact agreed that in this case it was not conclusive.

This imagery was not available to the clerk of the course during the active race session and is deemed to be relevant.
