### **Brief Details:**

The conditions were wet and very slippery. Car 1 overtook Car 5 on the entry to Park Corner. Car 1 then lost control and rear stepped out allowing Car 5 to overtake on the exit from Park Corner. The two cars entered Chris Curve side by side with Car 5 ahead. Slight side to side contact occurred as the cars proceeded around Chris Curve. There was no obvious reason for the contact. I find no driver wholly or predominantly responsible for the contact.
