Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 - Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car concerned

Brief Details:

Oliver Smith (Car 89) was ahead in the race. Kyle Townend (Car 19) was approaching car 89 on entry to the corner. Car 19 misjudged the racing line that car 89 was taking, and car 19 made minimal contact with the rear right of car 89. Car 19 is predominantly to blame for causing the collision, and mitigating circumstances were that the accelerator telemetry showed the removal of throttle prior to contact. No advantage was gained.
