Brief Details:

Reports for side-to-side contact on lap 4 for the race. Car 19, Kyle Townsend, was following Car 25, Richard Davies, through the corner. Car 99, Matthew Fox, split the two cars and was on a different racing line out wide, trying to overtake. On returning to the racing line, Car 99 and Car 19 made contact. Video footage was reviewed, and the driver's evidence was heard. No driver is predominantly to blame for this incident, and no further action was verbally given.
