Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s)

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 - Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car concerned

Brief Details:

Driver of Car 32 claimed that there was contact between their car (Car 32) and Car 2, this was not reported during the race by the Marshals. After watching onboard footage from Car 32 (front), it was apparent that there had been nose to tail contact with Car 2. Car 2 was summoned to see the Clerk and presented onboard footage (front). Both drivers were interviewed and after considering all of the evidence I find Car 2 to be guilty of causing a collision.

Evidence Relied Upon:

Oboard Car 32 (front), onboard Car 2 (front) and both drivers interviewed
