Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s)

Ch.2 App.8 Art.1.10 - Eligibility - post race scrutineering

Brief Details:

The Clerk of the Course received a report that Car 65 did not comply to the HTP papers in respect too:

- Double Adjustable Rear Dampers (Reg. Phil Cup - 3.7)
- Rear Dampers extended at the top (Reg. Phil Cup - 3.7)
- Adjustable rear anti-rollbar (Reg. Phil Cup - 3.7)
- No MSD 6AL ignition system (Reg. Phil Cup - 5.1)

While there is no evidence the competitor intended to be non-compliant with the HTP papers, no "exceptional reasons" were provided as to why the competitor should not be disqualified from the results of Race 8, Phil Hill Cup. The competitor was reminded that the HTP papers need to be corrected/updated if he believes the homologation is different from those in the HTP papers.

Therefore under NCR Ch. 2 App. 8 Art. 1.10 the Clerk of the Course has no option to disqualify Car 65 from the results of Race 8.

Be disqualified from the results of the race (Ch.2, App.2 Art 1 (e))
