Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s)

Ch.2 App.8 Art.1.10 - Eligibility - post practice scrutineering

Brief Details:

The Clerk of the Course received a non-compliant report from a MSUK Technical Commissioner, countered signed by a FIA Technical Commissioner, which under NCR Ch. 2 App. 8 Art 1.8 is considered to be a judge of fact. (A copy of the report is attached).

Following a hearing with driver car 9, I find there are no "exceptional reason" and under NCR Ch. 2 App. 8 Art 1.9 and 1.10, I must disqualify car 9 from the results of qualifying.

Subject to approval by the Eligibility Scrutineers, you may take part in the race, at the rear of the grid with a 10second penalty under NCR Ch. 2 App. 8 Art 1.21.

Disqualified from the results of qualifying practice and competitors practice times disallowed and subject to re-scrutineering (Ch.2, App.2 Art 1 (e))
