Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 - Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car concerned

Brief Details:

Contact between cars 15 and 188 at turn 1
Car 15 made heavy contact with the barrier and retired, car 188 continued but did not finish the race

Evidence Relied Upon:

Onboard cameras not mandated and not provided as evidence by either driver.
Both drivers interviewed separately
Live Stream video reviewed and shown to both drivers

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK NCR Ch.5A App.5 Art.2.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Be given a grid place penalty effective on your next race (Ch.2, App.2 Art 1 (d))
Number of Licence Penalty Points: **3**

Having reviewed the live stream video, and speaking with both competitors, I accept that car 15 made an error of judgement and lack of spatial awareness.

However, I feel the contact was avoidable and apportion whole blame on car 15.

I therefore order that you be given a 5 (FIVE) place grid penalty to be served at your next race

You are reminded of your right of appeal.

Any penalties applied will be recorded by Motorsport UK in accordance with NCR Ch.2 App.12 Art.1.1 (2.12.1.1).
