### **Brief Details:**

Car 23 and car 80 make side to side contact at turn 1. Car 80 moves off circuit and rejoins.

Car 23 does lose the rear of the car causing minor side to side contact however given the conditions it was not determined whether car 80 was going to leave the track anyway given the speed they took into the corner.

No further action taken as neither driver could be predominantly held responsible for the incident.
