As the Clerk of the Course, I was informed by the Championship Coordinator that a team representative had not attended the Championship briefing and after hearing from the team manager I consider there was a breach of Championship regulations and National Competition Rules.

As a result, I determine the following:

**Session**            Briefing


**Facts**                The team manager did not attend the mandatory briefing

**Offence**             CR 3.2.1 - Arriving late at or failing to attend a scheduled drivers and team managers briefing

**Decision**            Under NCR 2.2.2 and CR 4.2, I order that you should be penalised

	By means of a written reprimand
X	Be fined a sum of £300 (minimum £300)
0	No penalty points are awarded for this action

**Reason**             The team manager explained that he was involved with a personal issue which is fully understood however his predicament could have been communicated to someone else within the team who could have attended in his place. This penalty is in line with that prescribed within the regulations for the Championship
