Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s)

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.5.f - Manoeuvres liable to hinder other drivers such as deliberate crowding of a vehicle beyond the edge of the track or any other abnormal change of direction

Brief Details:

Incident involving Car 16 and Car 27 at Turn 10 (esses out). Contact between Cars 16 and Car 27 resulting in both cars impacting the pit wall at pit entry.

Interviewed the drivers of Cars 16 & 27 and reviewed onboard from both cars and from Car 7 which was immediately behind this incident.

Car 16 was compromised by an overtaking manoeuvre on entry to the esses and did not leave sufficient room to their right for Car 27 at the exit.

Evidence Relied Upon:

Onboard footage from cars 7, 16 & 27

Accordingly, under Motorsport UK NCR Ch.5A App.5 Art.2.3, I hereby order that you receive the following:

Be given a 5 place grid place penalty effective on your next race (Ch.2, App.2 Art 1 (d))
