Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s)

## **Brief Details:**

Car 87 was reported for speeding excessively on leaving parc ferme to a championship official.

Car 87 was invited to interview with myself and the championship official it was reported to. The championship official explained the issue and the driver consistently defended his actions.

When discussed the driver then asked if they could leave, we agreed they could, on leaving he said "Uh Craig, you need to sort your stuff out".

Driver called back into race control to discuss the comment - driver was much calmer this time and apologised for their actions. After a discussion, the driver was informed that they were DSQ from the race session (Race 18) for mis-behaviour or unfair practice.
