Following investigations, I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR(s)

Ch.12 App.7 Art.1.8 - Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car concerned

Brief Details:

Car 95 made heavy contact with the rear of car 81 at T1 on the last lap causing car 81 to lose control and several places in the race.

It was noted in the judicial hearing that the driver of car 95 apologised for the incident

Driver of car 95 to receive a 5 place penalty in the race

Championship regulation 4.2.2 iii) a 3 place grid penalty to be served at the next available race

Evidence Relied Upon:

Onboard evidence of cars 95, 81 & evidence car viewed

Drivers and team managers of cars 95 & 81 gave verbal evidence in the hearing

Be penalised by the addition of position(s) to your race finishing position (Ch.2, Ann. A, Art. 1.3)
