It's the dawn of a new era for the Caffeine & Machine Caterham Academy Championship this year as more fresh-faced rookie drivers prepare to take their inaugural steps into world of motor racing, and it all starts at Donington Park.

Renowned for being a series that is exclusive for first-time racers, the Academy has been running since 1995 and in that time it has seen more than 1,200 drivers pass through its ranks; with many of them going on to enjoy great success.

The Academy consists of Caterham offering an all-inclusive 'introduction to motorsport' package, which includes a Caterham Horse HR13 powered road-legal race car, race licence, technical support, the racing itself and the guidance of the Caterham team at every stage.

Importantly, no professional teams are permitted to compete in the championship, which ensures a level-playing field for all competitors and the perfect proving ground as they gain the experience necessary to thrive and progress.

The 'Class of 2026' familiarised themselves with their machines and each other in early May at an event at Curborough however it is Donington Park - and its National layout - that provides the first test for the field with two races slated to take place.

The Bilstein Caterham Roadsport Championship reaches the halfway point of the 2026 season at Donington Park this Saturday and with the battle for supremacy heating up, all eyes will be on the lead protagonists as they jostle for supremacy.

Effectively year two of the Caterham Academy Championship, the Roadsport category is the second step on the Caterham Motorsport and as such, much of this year's grid know each other well having competed against each other last year.

Simple developments to the car - including track-focused Nova ZZS tyres and a rear anti-roll bar - offers driver progression in what is relatively similar machinery to that of last year; all while now in a double-header race format.

Visits to Cadwell Park, Croft and the Spa-Francorchamps have provided copious amounts of entertainment so far, and its

been Richard Davies that has claimed a majority of the plaudits as well.

Tallying a brace of wins at both Cadwell Park and Croft, Davies will be eager to extend his advantage in the standings, especially as looking to return to winning ways after Oliver Smith scored a double of his own last time out in Belgium.

Mitchell Fasanya may not have won a race yet but his consistency towards the front of the field has ensured that he arrives at Donington Park as the preverbal meat in the sandwich of Davies and Smith.

Kyle Townend is another name that has been among the podium positions this season and he, like many others, will be aiming to make his mark towards the sharp end of the grid under the flight path of East Midlands airport.

Other notable names to keep an eye on over the course of what is being touted as a 'Super Saturday' is Jason Spencer, John Bond, Rob Hicks, Heinrich Watson-Miller, Oliver Walsh, Georgie Tuffin, Richard Watson and Mark Hensler.

Paul Oggelsby has been the early pace-setter in the FanDrive Caterham Seven 270R Championship this year, however he can't rest on his laurels as the chasing pack are nipping at his heels.

Marking the third rung on the Caterham Motorsport ladder, the series features drivers that have competed in both the Academy and Roadsport, while the addition of a third race and support from professional teams ups the ante further.

The Seven 270R car progresses the Roadsport race car too by switching from road to track suspension, plus the removal of the windscreen and lights to make it look and feel like the racing machine that it is.

Oggelsby - who is a former Academy champion - has started his campaign with a flurry of strong results, many of which have been race wins, and its that front-running form that he will be looking to maintain on Donington's National layout.

Behind him, the quartet of Sebastian Tholet, Henry Speeks, Luciano Caruso and Alastair Morton have all enjoyed standout

performances whilst Brian Thornton has tasted victory on a handful of occasion too.

Such is the competitive nature of this year's Seven 270R grid, the likes of Aaron Oliver, Oliver White, Scott Helme and Jasmine Shaw have been consistent performers to net themselves a spot inside the top ten as it currently stands.

Renownee for delivering unmissable wheel-to-wheel battles, the fight for supremacy is not just consigned to those that have been at the front of the field so far this campaign.

Be sure to keep an eye on the likes of Andrew Davison, Craig Evans, Jimmy Wai, Steve Lorriman, Christian Bond, Ryan Tholet, Charles Chapman, Chris Morling, Gary Cross and Shane Forster to name but a few.

Things couldn't be much closer at the top of the Vertex Caterham Seven 310R Championship heading into Donington Park this weekend, with several drivers firmly in the mix towards the top of the standings.

Providing the penultimate step on the ladder for the proficient race driver in a car that started life in the Academy Championship the Seven 310R category is the ultimate evolution of the Academy car, the machines that compete in the 310R ranks produce in excess of 152bhp.

Having already make a popular guest appearance on the British Touring Car Championship support bill at Brands Hatch, the Seven 310R category has delivered plenty of blockbuster moments - and more are expected this weekend.

Blending experienced racers with fledgling talents, this year's entry list is one of the

most competitive in recent memory and sitting atop the pile going into the weekend is multiple Caterham title winner Paul Goldstein.

Using all his know-how in the one-make series, Goldstein has fought his way to the standings summit in recent rounds. However he can't rest for a moment as behind him are two formidable brothers - Charles Harris and William Harris.

The Harris' have made an instant impact on their graduation to the Seven 310R grid and they'll be eager to strengthen their positions around the flowing corners of Donington Park's National layout.

William Chadwick is well within striking distance too while Ben Lopez Appleton and Richard Cooper currently complete the top-six.

Others to be on the lookout for this weekend include Alex Vincent. Chris Buck, Sam Parker and Tim Hardcastle - to name but a few.

FLAG SIGNALS



BLUE

(Steady) Another competitor is close.

(Waved) Another competitor is trying to pass.



YELLOW

(Waved) Danger ahead; no overtaking, slow down, be prepared to stop.

(Double Waved) Great danger ahead; no overtaking, slow down, be prepared to stop.



WHITE

Service vehicle or very slow car on circuit.



YELLOW/RED STRIPES

Slippery surface ahead.



GREEN

Proceed, hazard indicated has been cleared.



RED

Stop Racing, proceed slowly to pits or startline as instructed by a marshal (at startline and individual marshal's posts). Race stopped.



BLACK/ORANGE DISC

Warning of mechanical failure which might not be obvious to the driver; call into pits immediately.



BLACK/WHITE DIAGONAL

Warning to drivers that his/her behaviour (e.g corner cutting) is suspect and he/she may be black flagged.



BLACK

Driver must call in immediately and report to the Clerk of the Course.



BLACK & WHITE CHEQUERED

End of the race.
