## Event Final Instructions, Season, and Event Drivers Briefing Notes

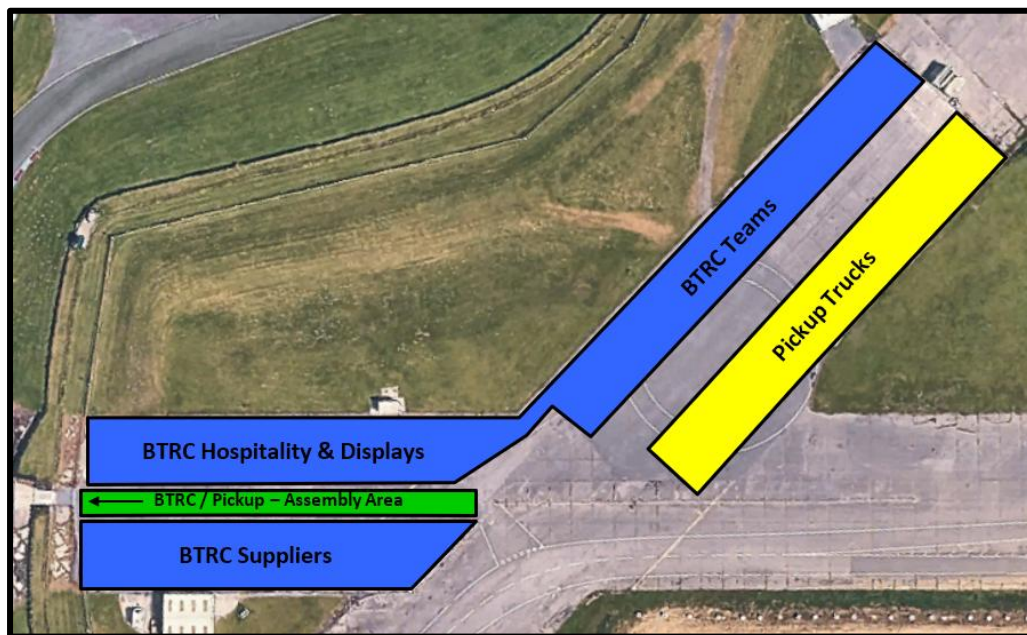

## Assembly Area

All trucks must go to the assembly area marked on the paddock plan. (please see final instructions (<https://www.barc.net/wp-content/uploads/2026/06/HQ08-Finals-v1.0-PUB-120626.pdf> )



For qualifying, you will be released onto the track via a course car and enter the pit lane. When the circuit is ready, you will then be released onto track for your session.

For races you will be released to the grid.

## **Start Procedure**

As per the Championship Regulations 3.6.9.4, the location at which overtaking is permitted is after the start is:

**Overtaking is permitted at the start, once the Red Lights have been extinguished..**

## **End of Qualifying and Races**

At the end of all qualifying and races, pickups will take the chequered flag, slow down complete a lap and come into the Pit Lane where you will be under parc fermè conditions.

When all pickups are together in the pit lane, you will proceed from pit exit to the paddock gate and proceed directly to Parc Ferme.

All trucks remain under Parc Ferme conditions from the chequered flag until released by **Pickup Technical Team** under **Chris Baker**.

## **Driving Conduct**

All incidents reported to Race Control will be investigated.

## **Light Panels**

Pembrey Circuit is equipped with light panels these are the primary signals. In addition, flag signals at Marshal Posts may supplement the light panels.

## **Other Points to note:**

- Competitors are reminded that the use of 2 wheeled vehicles including electric scooters is prohibited in all areas of the venue.
- Entrants, Teams, and Competitors must ensure that all vehicles are used in accordance with manufactures instructions and under no circumstances should anyone be allowed to ride or hang on to buggies, roll bars, side pods etc.
- Paddock vehicles with a capacity under 125cc may only be driven by a holder of a full UK provisional or greater, driving license.
- Paddock vehicles with a capacity over 125cc must be driven by a holder of a full UK driving license. (BARC Standing Regulations, Section 12).

Please be aware that all Motorsport UK meetings are run in accordance with Race with Respect guidelines to encourage a positive environment for everyone involved in race meetings whether it be competitors, teams, officials, marshals or spectators.
