As the Clerk of the Course, I became aware of an incident and as a result held a hearing to determine if there was any breach of either Championship regulations or the National Competition Rules. I reviewed video evidence which was available from ITV, car 132 and car 52 and in addition heard from James Dorlin and Ben Taylor (Restart Racing). Also present were Dave White (Clerk of the Course) and James Cole (Driving Standards Advisor).

As a result of the hearing, I determine the following:

Car No / Driver 132 / James Dorlin

Entrant Restart Racing

Session Qualifying Race

Facts There was contact between car 132 of James Dorlin and car 52 driven by Gordon Shedden.

Offence NCR 12.7.1.8 Causing a collision, repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the car

Decision Under NCR 2.2.2 and CR 4.2, I order that you should be penalised

X
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Be officially reprimanded,

Be penalised by the addition of 5 seconds to your race time.


Be penalised by means of a three place grid penalty for your next race

Be disqualified from the results of the race for championship round 30

This counts as a "strike", CR 4.4.5 with the grid place penalty to be taken at Round ...

Penalty points are awarded for this action

Reason There was contact between the two cars turning into turn 5 which resulted in car 52 going off track and car 132 gained positions. The penalty imposed is in line with previous penalties applied for such offences.
