Additional Information / Reasons for Decision

Report of car 85 not slowing down under double waved yellow signal. Car 85 was following car 43 through the double waved yellows and closed the gap. On review of the footage and interviews with the drivers, Car 43(Stephen Treherene) slowed down more than car 85 but both drivers were under control and slowed down.
