Following investigations I find that you are guilty of contravening the following Motorsport UK NCR:

Ch.12, App. 7, Art. 1.8 – Causing a collision and / or repetition of serious mistakes or the appearance of a lack of control over the Vehicle

Additional Information / Reasons for Decision / Evidence:

Report of contact between Car 71 (Ryan McLeish), Car 94 (Angus Scrivener) and Car 68 (Nick Bridgeman). On reviewing the footage, Car 71 did not anticipate the breaking point of the two cars in front, Cars 94 and 68. Car 71 carried more speed into the braking point of Turn 1 and caused a collision into the back of Car 68. This collision then caused Car 71 to contact Car 68 into Turn 1. I find Driver of Car 71 (Ryan McLeish) wholly responsible for causing the collision and is penalised with a 30-second addition to the elapsed race time.
