As the Clerk of the Course, I became aware of an incident and as a result held a hearing to determine if there was any breach of either Championship regulations or the National Competition Rules. I reviewed video evidence which was available from ITV, car 2 and car 99 and in addition heard from drivers and team representative Carl Mitchell. Also present in the hearing was Dave White (Clerk of the Course).

As a result of the hearing, I determine the following:

Car No / Driver 2 / Daryl DeLeon

Entrant WSR

Session Race 2

Facts Cut the Chicane and in doing so completed the overtaking of car 99

Offence NCR 2.A.1.3 Obtaining an unfair advantage (whether inadvertently or not)

Decision Under NCR 2.2.2 and CR 4.2, I order that you should be penalised

	By the addition of . . . seconds to your race time for the result of Championship round
X	By means of a one place penalty for the result of Championship round 14
	By means of a . . . place grid penalty applied on the next Championship round that it can be taken
	By means of a written reprimand
0	No penalty points are awarded for this action

Reason Car 2 was on the outside of car 99 going into the Chicane but short cut the centre section of the Chicane and overtook car 99. The penalty imposed is in line with previous penalties applied for such offences.
